



Spring 2008 Nourishing the Planet Podcast Contest

Contest Guidelines

Each entry must be created by a group of 4-6 students enrolled in grades 5-12. The students' teacher or organization leader will need to verify that the students created the podcast, and will serve as the primary contact throughout the contest. All entrants must agree that the submitted podcast can be posted to the Nutrients for Life Foundation Web site, and can be used at the discretion of the Foundation.

The podcast must contain at least one of the following topics related to the curriculum:

1. Essential Nutrients
2. Properties or Elements of Soils
3. Plant-Soil Interactions
4. Plant Nutrient Deficiencies
5. Our Environment and Soils
6. Nourishing the Planet/ Feeding the World
7. Global Population Growth Issues

The podcasts should be at least 1 minute long, but no longer than 5 minutes. Content must be of the student's own creation; complete clips from professional sources will not be accepted. Audio, audio with pictures, and video entries are all open to judging, although all within the same category.

To submit your entry, please submit the completed entry form and podcast file to podcast@nutrientsforlife.org. If your file is too large, please e-mail podcast@nutrientsforlife.org and the Foundation will send further directions for uploading.

Entrants will be notified upon the receipt of the podcast file. The top finalists of the Spring semester contest will be notified if their podcast has been selected for online voting by May 12, 2008.
